1. TECHNICAL DETAILS

1.1 Aircraft Affected

All DA20-A1 aircraft.

1.2 Subject

The improvement in the design of the Nose Landing Gear (NLG) Fork assembly. The old P/N 20-3220-08-00 has been replaced with the new NLG Fork assembly, P/N 20-3220-08-00 1.

1.3 Reason

Cracks have been found on some NLG Fork assembly, P/N 20-3220-08-00 during routine inspections. Cracking usually occurs on higher time aircraft but could occur sooner with rough field operations or hard landings. Figure 1 shows where the cracking has normally occurred. Also, the machine screw, pan head, P/N MS35207-282 (see Figure 1) should be installed with Loctite 242 when the wheel fairings are not used to avoid any potential cracking that may occur at that location.

1.4 Information

Refer to DA20-A1 Aircraft Maintenance Manual (AMM) Document No. DA201-A1, Revision 15 dated 01 August 2011 or later revisions for new inspection requirements for the NLG and the Illustrated Parts Catalogue (IPC), Document No. DA203-A1, Revision 4 dated 15 September 2011 or later approved revisions.

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
