

Pilatus PC-12 Courses for Pilots

"Diamond Flight Training" is an "Approved Training Organisation" (ATO) according to EASA Part-FCL holding the Approval Certificate No. AT.ATO.152 issued by Austro Control, the Civil Aviation Authority of Austria.

For the Pilatus PC-12 (Series 10) and PC-12 NG we offer the following courses:

Course covered by this information leaflet:

 Theoretical ground course for the Pilatus PC-12 (Series 10) and PC-12 NG Type Rating

Additional courses are:

- High Performance Aircraft (**HPA**) (**not included** in the PC-12 theoretical ground course, and available only after individual coordination!)
- Flight Training for the PC-12 Type Rating

The Pre Entry Requirements are:

Pre entry requirements and course syllabi are primarily established for holders of an EASA Part-FCL license. Holders of other than EASA Part-FCL licenses would have to investigate with their Civil Aviation Authority whether our courses fulfil their licensing requirements.

Pre-entry requirements - Pilatus PC-12 Series 10 and PC-12 NG Type Rating Training

- PPL (A) or higher
- SEP (A) or MEP (A) Class Rating
- Valid medical certificate
- At least 200 hours total flying experience
- At least 70 hours as pilot-in-command of aeroplanes

Credits for previous experience

(Credit for HPA - High Performance Aeroplane)
If the applicant for a Pilatus PC-12 Type Rating

- is the holder of an ATPL (A), or
- has the theoretical knowledge credit for the ATPL (A), or
- holds a certificate of satisfactory completion of a pre-entry approved HPA course, or
- has a "HPA class- or type rating" entered in his license already,

he need not attend the course module "HPA – High Performance Aeroplane".

Time Scale for the theoretical ground course:

5 days theoretical instruction.

HPA course and PC-12 flight training:

Not included in the theoretical course package and available only after individual coordination.

Fee for the theoretical course:

Fee includes VAT (20%)	EUR
Pilatus PC-12 theoretical ground course (5 days) (including lunch)	2.820,

Course fee has to be pre-paid before starting the course.

After your registration you will get an invoice. Payment must be done latest 5 days before the course starts!

Course attendance will be confirmed only after payment has been received.

Accommodation is not included.

Registration:

Please place your registration at the earliest possible date, **latest 2 weeks prior** the start of the training.

For later registrations attendance cannot be guaranteed.
