

# "Diamond Flight Training" Courses for Pilots

"Diamond Flight Training" is an "Approved Training Organisation" (ATO) according to EASA Part-FCL, holding the Approval Certificate No. AT.ATO.152 issued by Austro Control, the Civil Aviation Authority of Austria.

All trainings will be performed at Diamond Aircraft Industries facilities in Wiener Neustadt, Austria (LOAN).

DA40NG theoretical courses are not routinely scheduled. DA40 differences trainings are provided (if necessary) in the weeks scheduled for DA42, DA62 differences trainings/MEP trainings, or they can be arranged individually.

# Flight training:

### **Prerequisites:**

Training on customer's aircraft	Training on aircraft rented from Diamond	
Customer accepts training on his aircraft.	Aircraft availability must be checked.	
Aircraft on a Diamond "Permit to fly" with crew	Fuel, maintenance, consumables included.	
training purpose	Diamond insurance policy available.	
Aircraft on customer's registration and fully certified under your country's legislation (holding an unrestricted C of A, not just put onto the register),	However, aircraft could be used for other purposes on short notice.	
with customer's insurance including training purpose, and an accident insurance for all of the seats occupied (minimum EUR 40.000,per seat). This insurance must also cover the pilots (not only "passengers").		
Use of the aircraft is on customer's expenses, but fuel costs will be included in the prices charged by Diamond.

### **Pre Entry Requirements:**

Pre entry requirements and course syllabi are primarily established for holders of an EASA Part-FCL license. Holders of other than EASA Part-FCL licenses would have to investigate with their Civil Aviation Authority whether our courses fulfil their licensing requirements.

### **Pre-entry requirements - MEP Class Rating Training**

PPL (A) or higher

SEP (A) Class Rating

Valid medical certificate

At least 70 hours as pilot-in-command of aeroplanes

#### Pre-entry requirements - DA42NG, -VI, DA62 Differences Training

PPL (A) or higher

MEP (A) Class Rating - Single Pilot

Valid medical certificate

#### Pre-entry requirements - DA40NG Differences Training

PPL (A) or higher

SEP (A) Class Rating

Valid medical certificate

#### Credit for "previous G1000 experience"

Even if "previous G1000 experience" is indicated in the course registration, trainees have to expect an "introductory test on G1000 subjects" and possibly additional G1000 instruction to cover G1000 details specific to Diamond aircraft.

#### Diamond Twin Conversion - DA42 to DA62 or v.v.

### Time Scale for the Courses:

**Theoretical MEP Class Rating Trainings** and **Differences Trainings** will start on **Monday** at 0900 am.

#### Attention:

If you intend to take **flight training** in Wiener Neustadt, not just the theoretical course, for Differences Training plan to stay here at least **some days of the second week**. For a MEP Class Rating plan to stay **even longer!** 

# Registration:

Please place your registration at the earliest possible date, **latest 2 weeks prior** the start of the training.

For later registrations attendance cannot be guaranteed.

We also reserve the right to cancel a course for operational reasons.

This decision will be made **1 week** prior the proposed start of the training. In this case we will propose an alternative date – what we will also do in case of overbooking, or we will propose to arrange an individual course at a higher fee which will be negotiated

Please indicate whether for flight training you will provide your own aircraft or you will need a chartered aircraft.

For DA42/DA62 courses it is absolutely necessary to indicate whether you need just Differences Training or a complete MEP Class Rating.
