1. TECHNICAL DETAILS

1.1 Aircraft Affected

All DA 40, DA 40D, DA 40F and DA 40 NG aircraft

1.2 Subject

Change in type design responsibility from Diamond Aircraft Industries GmbH (Austria) to Diamond Aircraft Industries Inc.

1.3 Reason

The type design responsibility for the DA 40 series aircraft has been transferred from Diamond Aircraft Industries GmbH to Diamond Aircraft Industries Inc. This includes a change in the oversight of the type design from EASA to Transport Canada. Diamond Aircraft Industries Inc. is now responsible for the content and publishing of all technical publications, including the AFM, AMM, Service Bulletins and Service Letters

1.4 Information

The change in the type design responsibility includes all continuing airworthiness activities which will be managed by Diamond Aircraft Industries Inc. There is no change to the technical information that has been published previously. All Service Letters and Service Bulletins issued by Diamond Aircraft Industries GmbH continue to be applicable.

The AFM's and AWL's have been approved by Transport Canada. The following documents are published as identified in the following table and are now part of the current approved manuals. These documents must be added to the current AFM and AMM for each model.
