As a result of this transfer the aircraft flight manual (AFM) has been reissued under a new document number. This AFM is a revision of the original AFM, 7.01.25-E, and includes all supplements. The new AFM document number is 11.01.05-E and is now the approved AFM for the DA 62 model. The 7.01.25-E AFM will no longer be revised.
